*George Robison, Executive Director, TRFMA*

This in-depth seminar will focus on the risk of damaging floods on the Truckee River, how they are often forgotten afterwards, and how this can affect policy and human actions along a river course. This seminar will show examples of “flood amnesia” throughout the country, including past examples such as floodplain and floodway development creep, loss of readiness for flooding, and loss of momentum in working through mitigation measures. Examples will be given from dam safety, general planning, and floodway and floodplain management. Solutions to flood amnesia include flood awareness programs, high water markers, and creating informative and visually captivating material on what floods can do. A discussion on how to better communicate the risk of flooding will follow the presentation.
