

The Truckee River Flood Management Authority (TRFMA), in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of TRFMA's intent to revise the flood hazard information, generally located along the Truckee River from White Fir Road bridge in Reno, NV downstream to Wadsworth, NV. Flood hazard information along two tributary streams will also be revised. These are: Steamboat Creek, from South Meadows Parkway downstream to the confluence with the Truckee River, and the North Truckee Drain from Vintage Hills Lane downstream to the confluence with the Truckee River.

As a result of the revision, the regulatory floodway shall be revised, the 1% annual chance water-surface elevations shall be revised, and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall be revised within the area of revision. The revised Truckee River floodplain will be tied into the existing detailed flood mapping near White Fir Road on the upstream end and near Wadsworth on the downstream end.
